November	<p>Finalize applications that you want to be out by Christmas. "Mid-Year Reports section of the college applications must be turned in to the guidance office. Check in the guidance office to see if the FAFSA forms are in.(Free Application For Student Aid)</p>
December	<p>EA/ED responses should be sent out. Rolling Admission application responses should be coming out.</p>
January	<p>Submit your completed FAFSA as soon as possible after January 1st.</p>
