April	Good time to start visiting colleges during Easter vacation. Review materials given out at workshop on "Visiting Colleges." Work with counselor to finalize college choices. Take your ACT's.
May	Take SAT or ACT. Make plans to continue visiting colleges over the summer. Prepare for AP exams. Prepare the drafts of the college essay
June	Prepare for finals. Take the SAT. Finalize your college choices.
July	Prepare for the SAT in the fall. Work on that ESSAY! Begin requesting college applications.
August	Set up interviews for colleges Gather your art portfolios(art majors) Make preparations for auditions (dance majors)
